

Matt 24:21 For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be.




Rev 10:2 He had a little scroll open in his hand. And he set his right foot on the sea, and his left foot on the land,




Rev 10:3 and called out with a loud voice, like a lion roaring. When he called out, the seven thunders sounded.




Rev 5:2 And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and break its seals?"



Psalm 103:20 Bless the LORD, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word!




Matt 26:53 Do you think that I cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels?

Psalm 91:11 For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.




Rev 10:5 And the angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand to heaven




2 Peter 1:3 His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence,

1 Cor 13:12 For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.




