

***Joel 2:1 Blow a trumpet in Zion; sound an alarm on my holy mountain!
Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble, for the day of the Lord is
coming; it is near***

Ezekiel 33:11 As I live, declares the Lord God, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways, for why will you die, O house of Israel?

Proverbs 24:17 Do not rejoice when your enemy falls, and let not your heart be glad when he stumbles,

REV 8:1-2 1 When the Lamb opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. 2 Then I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

Matt 24:6-8 6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet. 7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. 8 All these are but the beginning of the birth pains.

Job 13:5 Oh that you would keep silent, and it would be your wisdom!

Prov 17:28 Even a fool who keeps silent is considered wise; when he closes his lips, he is deemed intelligent.

REV 8:3 And another angel came and stood at the altar with a golden censer, and he was given much incense to offer with the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar before the throne,

REV 8:4 and the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, rose before God from the hand of the angel.

REV 8:5 Then the angel took the censer and filled it with fire from the altar and threw it on the earth, and there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake.

1 John 5:14-15 And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him.

REV 8:5 Then the angel took the censer and filled it with fire from the altar and threw it on the earth, and there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake. 6 Now the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to blow them.

2 Thes 2:7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work. Only he who now restrains it will do so until he is out of the way.

(v7) The First Trumpet – 1/3 of Vegetation Ruined

(v8-9) The Second Trumpet — 1/3 of Sea Life Killed

(v10-11) The Third Trumpet — 1/3 of Water Supply Ruined

(v12) The Fourth Trumpet — 1/3 of Light Gone

REV 8:13 Then I looked, and I heard an eagle (some translations translate angel) crying with a loud voice as it flew directly overhead, "Woe, woe, woe to those who dwell on the earth, at the blasts of the other trumpets that the three angels are about to blow!"

Isa 45:22 Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.
