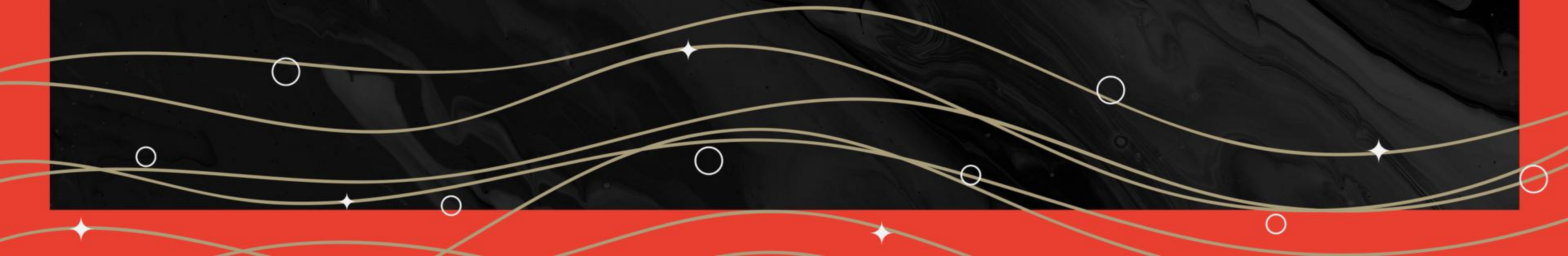


A RESPONSE OF WORSHIP

LUKE 1:39-40

In those days *Mary* arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a town in Judah, and she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth.

LUKE 1:41-42
