GO!

Matthew 28:18-20 “Jesus came and told his disciples, “I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. (19) Therefore, **go** and **make** disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. (20) **Teach** these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am **with** you always, even to the end of the age.” (NLT)

Romans 1: 16 “For I am **not** ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that **brings** salvation to **everyone** who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.” (NIV)

Luke 19:10 “For the Son of Man came to **seek** and to **save** the lost.” (NIV)

What does it mean to GO?

Def: to move along in a **specified** manner : to take a **certain** course or follow a certain procedure : to proceed **without** delay : to proceed in a thoughtless or reckless manner

What happens when we Go?

1. When we **GO** we **Dedicate** our lives to God's Great Commission

Matthew 28: 19 “Therefore **go** and **make** disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,” (NIV)

What does it mean to be Commissioned?

Def: the state of being **charged** with **specific** duties or responsibilities : **authority** to undertake or perform certain duties or functions

John 20: 19-22 “On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, “Peace be with you!” (20) After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord. (21) Again Jesus said, “Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, **I am sending you.**” (22) And with that he breathed on them and said, “Receive the Holy Spirit.” (NIV)

Luke 14: 23 “Then the master told his servant, ‘**Go** out to the roads and country lanes and **compel** them to come in, so that my house will be full.’” (NIV)

2. When we **Go** we fulfill Gods **Desire** to be in relationship with humanity

2 Peter 3: 9 “The Lord is **not** slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is **patient** with you, not wanting **anyone** to perish, but **everyone** to come to repentance.” (NIV)

Romans 10: 14-15 “How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? (15) And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How **beautiful** are the feet of those who **bring** good news!” (NIV)

3. When we **GO** we **Direct** humanity to salvation needed through Christ.

John 12: 32 “And I, when I am **lifted** up from the earth, will **draw** all people to myself.” (NIV)

John 14: 6 “Jesus answered, “I **am** the way and the truth and the life. No one **comes** to the Father except through me.” (NIV)

John 3: 18 “Whoever **believes** in him is not condemned, but whoever **does not** believe stands **condemned** already because they have not believed in the name of God’s one and only Son.” (NIV)

4. When we **GO** we **Demonstrate** our love for people

1 John 4: 19-20 “We love because he **first** loved us. (20) Whoever claims to love God yet hates a brother or sister is a **liar**. For whoever does not love their brother and sister, whom they have seen, **cannot** love God, whom they have not seen.” (NIV)

Matthew 10: 7-8 “As you **go**, proclaim this message: ‘The kingdom of heaven has come near.’ (8) Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have **received**; freely **give**” (NIV)

2 Corinthians 5: 14 “For Christ’s love **compels** us, because we are **convinced** that one died for all, and therefore all died.” (NIV)
